

Performers Information 2021

Before the show:

- Do NOT attend if you display any symptoms of Covid - 19
- We strongly encourage performers to take a lateral flow test on the morning of their show before attending
- Please ensure your child has eaten a good but light meal before they arrive and provide them with snacks and plenty of drinks for their time backstage. Do not send chocolate or Ribena drinks as they could get onto costumes causing damage. No performer will be allowed to consume any snacks containing nuts. Do not send any snack with nuts in them as this could be potentially harmful for those of our performers with severe allergies.
- Please talk with your child to remind them that they must not share food during their time at the theatre.
- Please label EVERYTHING your child brings with them so that it isn't lost. Do not send your child with expensive toys or jewellery as we can not except any responsibility should they become lost or damaged.
- All performers must arrive with their hair already ready. Female performers hair must be in a very neat straight back or middle parting bun. Fringes are acceptable but must be very neat and tidy. Boys hair must be neat and tidy and off the face.
- Make sure that your child has everything they need on their costume list including hair grips, pins, hairspray, bobbles etc in a box or bag they can carry themselves which is clearly labelled with their name and the running order for the show attached and highlighted so that our chaperones know which show numbers your child is performing in. Finale wear is Red Stalder Jacket, Red Stalder Hoodie, Show t shirt, Comp team tracksuit, Drama team t-shirt or any plain black t shirt, black leggings(Girls) or Stalder tracksuit bottoms, bare feet or Tan jazz shoes.
- Female performers, make up should be worn for all senior performers and festival team. This includes Base foundation, blusher, black eye liner, black mascara and lipstick(natural colours please). Boys too should wear very light makeup.
- Please advise Miss Carolyn via email no later than Thursday 1st July if your child has any medicals concerns we should be aware of that are not previously disclosed. For the safety of everyone any medications your child may need to have with them must be declared. If your child has medication for Asthma please make sure they have their relevant inhalers with them.

On arrival at the theatre Building:

- Do not arrive any earlier than 1 Hour 30 minutes prior to your Childs' showtime.
- Please arrive to the front door of the Building and only enter the building when instructed to do so.
- All those entering the building will be temperature checked.
- No parent will be allowed to enter the building unless they have been pre approved as a chaperone or helper for that performance.
- Please observe social distancing and form a queue outside the building entrance until you are admitted by our staff. Please talk to your child about the importance of keeping their distance for others whilst waiting.
- Please help us by not congregating in large groups before and after the event.
- Please ensure you wear a face covering whilst queuing and whilst inside the theatre unless medically exempt or under the age of 11 years.
- On entry to the building please sanitise your hands at the station provided.
- Please give your performers name to the member of staff on entry who will check them off the list and bring you into the building.
- Once performers have arrived they will then form a "Bubble", however we will still continue to encouraging all performers to maintain social distancing.

Whilst In the theatre :

- There will be a one way system throughout the backstage area.
- All performers must remain in their Dressing room and backstage area throughout their stay with us.
- All performers will be chaperoned
- If you have pre-ordered a souvenir show t-shirt they will be at the theatre for you in your dressing room on your arrival.

Leaving the Theatre:

- Performers will be shown to the exit doors at the back of the building once the performance has finished where they should be collected. We appreciate your patience in this process to ensure that every performer is signed out.

Performers age 16 years and over will be allowed to leave unaccompanied. We can not allow any performer under the age of 16 years to leave without their parent present.
